Program Evaluation

- Investigation of the merit and significance of activities of community groups
- Helps clarify program plans
- Improves communication among partners
- Gathers feedback needed for program effectiveness





Evaluating a specific program

- Decide:
- What will be evaluated
- What criteria will judge program performance
- What standards must be reached for the program to be considered successful
- What will indicate performance
- What conclusions are justified





Steps in program evaluation:

- Engage stakeholders
- Describe the program
- Focus the evaluation design
- Gather credible evidence
- Justify your conclusions
- Ensure use and share lessons learned



The four categories of evaluation standards:

- Utility
- Feasibility
- Propriety
- Accuracy
